Conor Lee Heats Things Up This Winter with New Single, “Sweat”

The 2022-2023 snow season subjected Midwesterners to one of the most relentless winters of recent memory. Sore from shoveling and deprived of Vitamin D, guitarist Conor Lee hunkered down and sought refuge in his imagination. Gradually returning to music after navigating creative burnout, Lee specifically set out to write a track that would be fun to perform, lift his spirits, and serve as a distraction from the cold (figuratively and literally) for himself and listeners. “I’m not really here” became a winter mantra and “Sweat” was born. Evoking images of deserts, tumbleweeds, and Spaghetti Western anti-heroes, “Sweat” is an energetic track that will transport listeners to somewhere else. Serving as a follow-up to his latest release, “[Candyland](#),” “Sweat” is part of a series of upcoming singles to be released by Lee in 2024.

Conor Lee is an active guitarist for a variety of different performing groups in the Minneapolis music scene. When he’s not supporting other musicians, Conor is writing and performing his own music. His years of experience as a sideman have allowed him to be immersed in many genres which has served as a foundation for Lee’s own writing. Blending alternative rock with lush soundscapes, jazz-influenced melodies, dancefloor drum grooves, and film scores, Lee’s music explores themes of nostalgia, soul-searching, escapism, and navigating hardship.
